Completed NWACC courses will be accepte by UAF and applied to the BSDH degree requirements according to the UAFS Undergraduate Academic Catalog. The remaining BSDH program requirements must be completed on the UAFS campus. Students must apply and be admitted into the Dental Hygiene Program. Selection is competitive based on courses, GPA, and interviews. Per the partnership agreement, UAFS will transfer 61 hours of lower division coursework for the BSDH.
